Corona Information

Hotel

2G

Rule 2G applies to the use of all hotel areas.
The 2G + rule in the wellness area.

Pure overnight

stay No certificate is required for pure overnight stays.
However, guests without a certificate must have meals in their room.

Children

Children up to the age of 15 are also welcome without 2G status, but
require a negative PCR or antigen test.

Restaurant

2G (vaccinated or recovered) applies in our restaurant .

Wellness

2G + applies in the wellness area and in the [Ovaverva](#) .

People whose vaccination, booster vaccination or recovery was not more than four
months ago are exempt from this test requirement.

In the fitness area of the [Ovaverva](#) , **2G with a mask** applies .

Entry into Switzerland

Guests with a 2G certificate who enter Switzerland from abroad must also show a negative PCR or antigen test at check-in.

Guests without a 2G certificate who enter Switzerland from abroad must show a negative PCR or antigen test upon check-in and also show another negative PCR or antigen test after four to seven days of stay in the hotel.

Certificates from Switzerland and the EU

Only Swiss COVID certificates and EU digital COVID certificates can be accepted.

Certificates from countries outside Switzerland and the EU

Guests who do not have a corona certificate from Switzerland or the EU must have their vaccination or recovery recognized before entering Switzerland. The federal government has provided an [internet platform for this purpose](#) . Please note: Recognition by the federal government can take up to five days. Without approval, interiors in which the rules “2G” or “2G +” apply may not be used.
